






WARNING

2 Safety Setting

- Place the shotgun flat on a table in front of you with the barrel pointing to the left and the pistol grip bottom toward you.
- The Safety/Fire Button is on the "SAFE" position ,if the Button is "Down" as in Fig 1.1.
- The Safety/Fire Button is on "FIRE" position, if the Button is "Up" as in Fig .1.2.
- To change the Safety/Fire position, press the button from the "Up" side to the opposite side.

3 Loading and Setting the Magazine

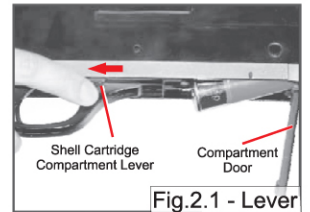


Fig.2.1 - Lever

- 1.Push Shell Cartridge Compartment Lever backward as in Fig .2.1 to open Compartment Door and take out the Cartridge.(Fig2.1)
- 2.Load 6mm BBs into the Speed Loader. We recommend using TSD .20g BB's and above. Using lower quality BB's will void TSD's 30 Day Warranty.
- 3.Align the tip of the Speed Loader to the pellets drop of the Shell Cartridge. (Fig2.2)
- 4.Push the spring Rod to load pellets into the Shell Cartridge.Repeat this process until the Shell Cartridge is full.(It can be loaded with 30 bullets.)
- 5.Place the Cartridge's metal head on the Compartment Door's Inner Step as in (Fig.2.3) and close the door to load the Cartridge.

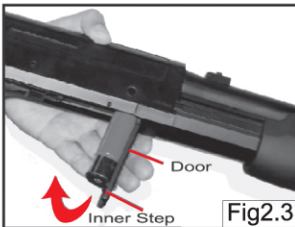
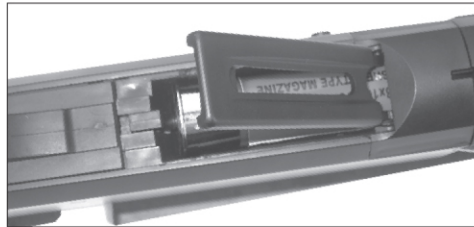

4 Firing

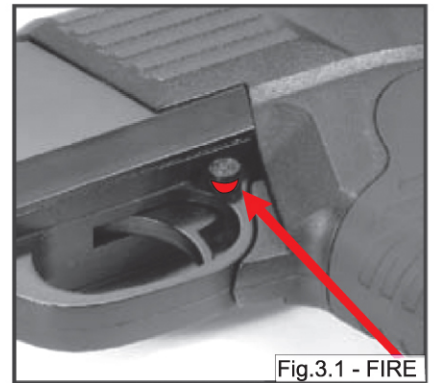


Fig.3.1 - FIRE

1. Set the Fire/Safety Button to the "FIRE" Position as in Fig.3.1.
2. Briskly pull the Pump Grip backward toward yourself until it clicks, and push it forward to complete the cocking in one continuous movement.
Note: You must do this to fire every shot.
3. Aim at your target and pull the trigger to fire.

2. Squeeze and hold the trigger and, concurrently, pull the Pump Grip backward and push forward to shoot.
3. By quickly moving the Pump Grip back and forth while holding the trigger, you can pump Triple-Shots out continuously.

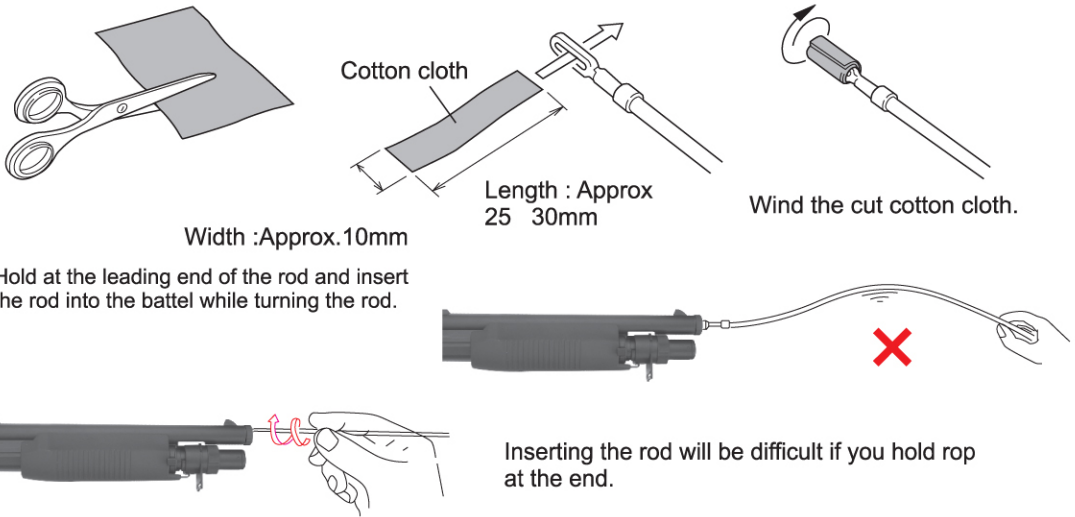
5 Maintenance

1. Maintenance when Bullet Speed Becomes low

- ① Apply Oil as shown below, using the cleaning rod and oiled cotton cloth. Insert cleaning rod into the barrel.
- ② To complete the cleaning, use the cleaning rod (with cotton) as shown below. To remove excess oil.

Warning

- Always carry out maintenance AFTER returning the hop up lever to the Normal position. (Hop-OFF)



2. Removing clogged bullets

- ① Remove the magazine and return the hop up adjustment to the Normal position.
- ② Insert the cleaning rod from the load edge of the barrel, be careful so that the angled part of the cleaning rod faces down, and remove clogged bullets.

3. Normal Maintenance

- Keep the rifle in clean condition.
- Never use dirty, damaged or distorted bullets.
- For best performance, Only Use TSD BB's



- Regularly clean the barrel with soft cleaning rod
